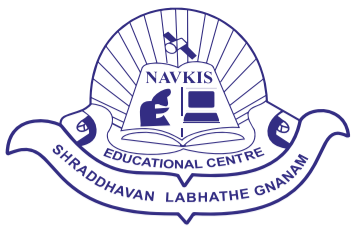

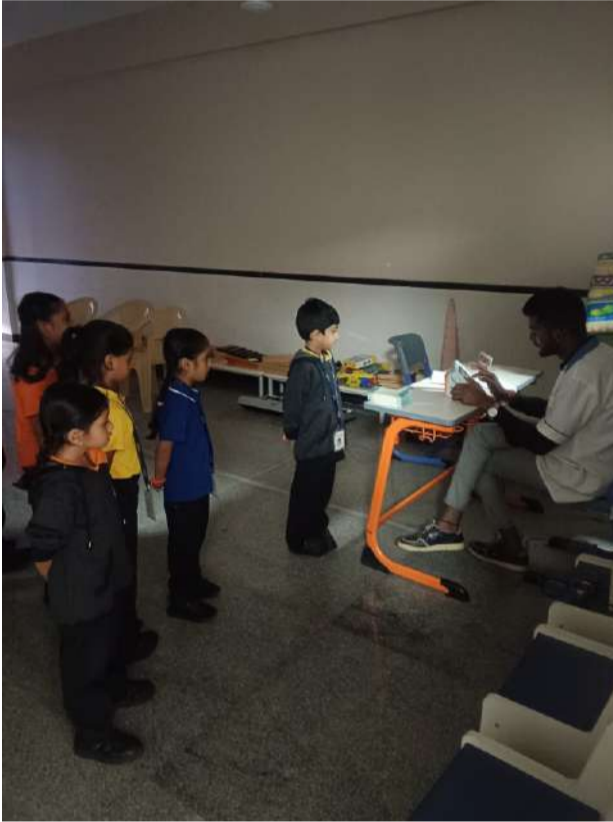

Vedic Mathematics:

“The Ancient Art of Calculation”

Vedic mathematics is an ancient Indian mathematical system rooted in the Vedas, the sacred Hindu scriptures. This unique system distinctive method of calculation was rediscovered in the early 20th century by Indian mathematician and scholar, Swami Bharati Krishna Tirtha. He decoded the mathematical concepts embedded in the ancient Vedic text and compiled them into a comprehensive system of mathematics. The Vedic mathematics system is based on 16 sutras (aphorisms) and 13 upa-sutras (sub-aphorisms) which provide a framework for solving mathematical problems simply, efficiently and creatively.

Benefits of Vedic Mathematics:

- Enhances speed and precision-It assists students in solving problems swiftly and accurately, thereby boosting their confidence and performance.
- Developmental math skills-It encourages mental calculations, which can improve cognitive abilities, memory and concentration.
- Enhances Problem-solving skills
- Builds a foundation for advanced math
- Reducing math anxiety

Overall, Vedic Mathematics offers a unique and powerful approach to mathematics that can benefit the students of all ages and skill levels.
